The Fruits of Holy Communion:

Indeed, the Lord said: 'He who eats my flesh and drinks my blood abides in me and I in him' (See Jn: 6,56). Life in Christ has its foundation in the Eucharistic banquet: 'As the Father sent me, and I live because of the Father, so he who eats me will live because of me ([See Jn: 6,57; CCC1391]).
