Amalgamation of Parishes: A joint meeting of the newly formed Parish Council and Finance Committees was held at Narborough last Monday. A general discussion took place in relation to the intention to bring the church of St. Pius X, Narborough, and the church of Our Lady of Victories & St. Alphonsus, Lutterworth, under one Parish. Fr. Joel provided a document that explains "How do parishes merge?" Many questions were raised about how we might be able to do this, and further information will be provided by the Parish Priest to inform Parishioners on how the process will be conducted going forward. Initially the request will be submitted to the Nottingham Diocese Council of Priests for consideration, and ultimately sanctioned by the Bishop. The timeline is expected to be February 2025. Further information will be provided in early January to all our Parishioners.
